ORIENTATION PROGRAMME



PHCER conducted an Orientation Programme for Semester 2 F.Y.B.Ed. student-teachers on 2nd July 2022. The objective of this programme was to acclimatize them to the Semester 2 Coursework, CCA, Internship and DLLE. They were oriented about examination, assignments, submissions, deadlines, core subjects, internship activities and DLLE work. The rationale for the orientation programme was to give them clarity about Semester 2 requirements and expectations. All student-teachers participated with zeal and enthusiasm.

MICRO - TEACHING AND DEMO LESSONS



Microteaching is a teacher training technique which provides student-

teachers an opportunity to perk up their teaching skills. PHCER conducted Micro Teaching and Demo Lesson sessions on 2nd July 2022 for F.Y. B. Ed. student-teachers to get acquainted with various teaching techniques. In the initial stage, the student teachers were trained to give lessons keeping in mind 3-4 minutes. Then sequentially; gradually after getting good results of teaching work, 30 to 40 minutes lessons were planned, prepared and executed.

ORIENTATION TO SEMESTER 2 INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

PHCER conducted an Internship Orientation Session on 2nd July 2022 and guided F.Y. B.Ed. student-teachers on the important components of school internship. Information regarding School Management structure, functioning, procedure of CCA, etc. were shared with the student-teachers. PHCER elaborated on the school activities to be carried out during 4 weeks (One Month Internship programme). The aim of the orientation was to sensitize student-teachers about their role and responsibilities during



internship. Student-teachers were made aware of the work profile to be followed during internship.

LESSON GUIDANCE SESSIONS



PHCER conducted lesson guidance sessions from 4th July to 9th July for F.Y.B.Ed. student-teachers to equip them with effective lesson plans for Internship and Practice Teaching in schools. Demonstration lessons were also given in the college to make them aware about the steps to be followed while teaching. Practice lessons were taken in college before sending student-teachers for real life teaching in schools. Timely guidance by method masters for lesson planning was provided.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME - PRACTICE TEACHING



PHCER F.Y.B.Ed. student-teachers carried out practice teaching lessons in actual classroom settings in the practice schools allotted to them by the college from 11th July to 30th July 2022. The student-teachers executed their planned and guided lessons in the classes 5 to 12. After the lesson was delivered by the student-teachers, feedback from the

supervisor to make the student-teachers aware about the strength and weakness was given on a regular basis. After giving feedback to individual student-teachers, a group feedback at the end of the day was also provided by the supervisor. All activities were systematically documented, maintained and submitted by the student-teachers for the purpose of internal assessment. Overall the Internship programme proved to be beneficial for student-teachers. It helped them to gain confidence to face the class and deliver lessons, improve their teaching skills, follow different methodologies of teaching; thus catering the needs of diverse students, develop classroom management skills, become more organized, develop in the area of professionalism etc.
